

# “Walking in Wisdom” Lesson 1

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**Main Text: James 1:1-11**

## Lesson Outline:

### 1. vs. 1: An Introduction

- This epistle was written by James to Jewish believers, many of whom faced hardship and persecution.
- James identifies himself as a **bondservant** of God.

### 2. vv. 2-8: Profiting from Trials

- v. 2: *Count it all joy*
- v. 4: The testing of our faith produces **patience and growth to maturity.**
- v. 5: God is the **source of Wisdom.**
- God has given us **everything** we need to be effective as Christians in this life (See 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:2-4)
- **Proverbs 3:5-6:** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup>In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.
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### 3. vv. 9-11 Glory in that which doesn't fade away

- A call for both the poor and the rich to glory in their future heavenly possessions.
- **The poor are called to glory in their future possessions, that they will be exalted in glory and those with earthly wealth the call is to not glory in your earthly possessions because those possessions are fleeting.**

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
