**Main Text: James 1:12-27**

### **Lesson Outline:**

#### **1. vv. 12-15: Enduring temptation; Obtaining the Crown of Life**

- You will face temptations and difficulty. These verses are a call to have the right mindset when facing temptations. We must be people that persevere.
- The Crown of Life is a reward given to those who endure well.
- God will never deliberately lead a person to commit sin. We must be on guard from the enemy (See 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 5:8)
- Our Savior understands difficulty (See Hebrews 4:14-16).

#### **2. vv. 16-20: God is unchanging.**

- We should respond to God’s unchanging nature by being quick to listen, and slow to speak, and slow to become angry. Longsuffering is one of the fruit of the Spirit that we can develop when we remain connected to God.
