Main Text: James 3:1-18

Lesson Outline:

- 1. vs. 1: Teachers to incur a stricter judgement**
 - See **1st Peter 5:1-4**. Teaching should not be taken lightly.
- 2. vv. 2-14: Taming the tongue**
 - See **1st Corinthians 9:24-27**. We should control our members and live in a disciplined manner.

Analogies in this passage - Bits in a horse’s mouth (vs. 3), A ship’s rudder (vs. 4), a fire in a forest (vs. 5), and wild beasts (vv. 7-8)

We learn from these analogies that the tongue (our speech) has a tremendous impact, an impact that can either be significantly positive or negative.

Controlling the tongue is a sign of maturity for the believer. *See 1st Corinthians 13:11.*

- 3. vv. 13-18: Wisdom from Above**
 - **Earthly Wisdom:** Bitter envy, self-seeking, earthly, sensual, demonic.
 - **Heavenly Wisdom:** Meekness, pure, peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality.
 - **We must watch how we walk in both word and deed.** *See Philippians 2:14-15.*
