Main Text: James 4:1-10

Lesson Outline:

1. vv. 1-3: Desiring pleasure is the ultimate trap

- Fleshly desires and attitudes we carry can and often do hinder church unity.
- God wants us to find contentment in Him. God wants to meet our needs. This passage reveals two primary reasons we may lack what we need.
 - o 1. We do not ask.
 - o 2. When we do ask, we don't receive because we ask amiss.

2. vv. 4-5: Friendship with the world is enmity with God

- Understanding the distinction of teaching by James and the Apostle Paul.
- Apostle Paul: Reminding the church of their *identity in Christ. (2nd Cor 5:17)*
- James challenges the church to walk in the wisdom of God in spite of any difficulties, so they'd be good examples to a watching world. *The accusations of adulterer* do not indicate their eternal reality of their position but speaks to the temporal danger caused by friendship with the world.

3. vv. 6-10: A call for submission and humility

- **Psalms 24:3-5** shows the picture of a pure heart.
- God wants us to have a pure heart before Him because God loves us. When our hearts are divided, we suffer the consequences.
