### Lesson Outline:

#### 1. vv. 1-6: Judgement for Rich Oppressors

- See *James 1:9-11*
- *See Matthew 6:19-21. Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth. These earthly treasures are fleeting.*
- There are three areas of sin mentioned that can result from the wrong view of wealth.
  - o Withholding just wages (verse 4), Self-indulgent living (verse 5), and condemning and harming the righteous (verse 6\_

#### 2. vv. 7-8: Be patient for the coming of the Lord

- Our hearts must be **established**.
- Establish your heart means to strengthen your faith so you are not easily shaken (1<sup>st</sup> Cor 15:58), Fix your heart on God’s promises rather than your own circumstances (Col 3:2), and to stand firm (James 1:12)
- We **must** consider our priorities.

#### 3. vv. 9-12: Persevering faith

- James warns believers to not grumble against one another, especially under hardship. **James reminds them that Jesus, the true Judge, is near, watching how they suffer and how they treat each other.**
- See **Psalm 103:8**
